#### The Spirit & The spirit

- 1. GOD: Three in ONE. Father. The Holy Spirit. Son.
- 2. The **s**pirit (human's individual spirit)
- 3. Holy Spirit in His children-

When we know that Jesus is the Son of GOD, and state that truth, the Holy Spirit enters us. We receive the **S**pirit that came after Jesus was glorified. John 7:39. That same **S**pirit leads us because we have faith; we belong to God; we can hear. (I John 4:4-6.)

The Bible speaks of The **S**pirit and the **s**pirit. In Matthew 22:45 when Jesus asked the Pharisees "Therefore, if David calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his son?" God revealed to David by His Spirit that Jesus is Lord - not only the physical kin of David's human seed.

In Matthew 5:3, the Beatitudes speak of the poor in **s**pirit. We who are alive in Christ can be "poor in spirit" *and* are blessed to have the kingdom of heaven, Jesus said. Blessed. Stop a moment. Think on this: we who are alive in Christ have His Kingdom!

Now, back to the **S**pirit, **s**pirit discussion from His Word: In Revelation 4:2 John said: "And immediately I was in the **s**pirit...." Then Holy **S**pirit showed John a throne and One Who sat on the throne.

Even Jesus had a human spirit when He said "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN

ME?" Matthew 27:46. The perfect Lamb of God had a human's individual spirit when He suffered and died, I believe. After the death for us sinners, *Holy* Spirit, *The* Spirit, the actual Spirit, raised Jesus from death. Hallelujah! See Revelation 11:11.

Jesus told us "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the **S**pirit saith unto the churches...." Revelation 2:7. Further, in Matthew 10:20 Jesus said to us "For it is not you who speak, but the **S**pirit of your Father who speaks in you."

God's Word and His Spirit have to work together "The two must always operate together", Derek Prince stated in <u>Prayer & Proclamations</u>. Let us read His Word and hear Him and speak his Words.
